ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

The US EPA finally issued an extension of time for compliance with the new SPCC rules. Specifics of the extension are as follows:

- A facility in operation on or before August 16, 2002 must amend its SPCC Plan, if necessary, to ensure compliance on or before February 17, 2006. The Plan must be implemented on or before August 18, 2006.
- A facility that becomes operational after August 16, 2002 through August 18, 2006 must prepare a Plan and fully implement it as soon as possible, but not later than August 18, 2006.
- A facility that becomes operational after August 18, 2006 must prepare and implement a Plan before it begins operations.

A complete description of the extension can be found in 40 CFR, Part 112.3.
